TERMS OF REFERENCE

The Patient Forum will consist of a selection of patients and Practice staff, who meet regularly to decide on ways of making a positive contribution to the existing services and facilities offered by the Practice to its patients.

Membership of the Patient Forum should reflect as broad a spectrum as possible of the Practice's registered patient list.

Feedback will be provided by the Practice Manager and GPs when requested or as required by the Patient Forum. Strict patient confidentiality will be maintained as required by statutory guidelines and opinions will be respected.

All meetings will take place on a quarterly basis, with a quorum of 4 members.

THE OBJECTIVES FOR PARKLANDS SURGERY PATIENT FORUM ARE TO:

- Provide resources and services for the good of the Practice patients which would not otherwise be provided by the normal statutory services.
- To encourage a spirit of self-help and support amongst patients to improve their health and wellbeing, especially those with long term illness.
- To help improve communication between the Practice, other Service providers, the Patient Forum and most importantly the patients.
- To instigate a regular Survey and to collate the results from patient feedback with the sole objective of improving their services.
- To promote a patient perspective and enable patients to access and make better use of the available health care, via notice boards, presentations, website or newsletter.
- One member will attend, represent and provide feedback from the Practice at East Northants Locality Patient Engagement Group meetings.
